5. What is the reason each of the facilities above were closed?

Lancewood Rest Home Limited closed because it was no longer financially viable as a result of low occupancy.

Nazareth Rest Home closed for two reasons. The Rest Home was owned and run by the Order of the Sisters of St Joseph. Their number were reducing, and they were getting older. The other reason was the significant investment required to meet future building compliance of the facility.
