

There are 153* new COVID-19 cases confirmed in the Whanganui district today.

We have 104 new confirmed cases in Whanganui, five new confirmed cases in Ruapehu and 44 new confirmed cases in Rangitikei.

We have one case in hospital. This case is in hospital being treated for COVID-19.

Since yesterday Whanganui rohe has 203 recovered cases.

The Whanganui district has a total of 897 active cases.
